The Green needs our help

The Friends are making a difference

The Green is struggling to cope with the intensity of demands users place on it. 44F Council doesn't have the money or resources to maintain it. let alone to improve it.

As a result the Green is showing signs of decline everywhere:

- The toilets are broken and have been for over 12 months
- The playground is being patched up time and again
- Tree roots are damaging the tennis courts
- Fences are broken and vandalised
- Grass areas have been deteriorating
- The 'kick-about' grass area had to be closed for 18 months to recover

Unless we supplement the H&F Council's resources and take greater responsibility for it ourselves, we are not going to get the Green our community wants and deserves!

As a small team of active volunteers. we are working hard on a broad range of areas that affect our quality of life.

Achievements since 2010

- Establishing a consensus for how we would like the Green to be
- Reopening the 'kick-about' grass area with a bigger maintenance grant
- Silver Park Award for falling crime levels
- Organising events like Brook Green Day fair
- Holding the Council to account and influencing how funding is spent
- £300,000 of donations and commitments secured already to upgrade the Green

Improvements planned 2012/13

- Renewal and expansion of the playground
- New pavilion with toilets, kiosk and tennis office – funding permitting
- Deliver new 'club quality' tennis courts operated and maintained by the Friends – funding permitting
- Install better fencing, lighting and security
- Improve drainage and reseeding of grass areas
- Reclaim the tarmac areas south of the tennis courts as a green area

A funding gap of £60,000 remains

These improvements planned for the Green will cost £485,000. We are working hard to secure additional funding to close this gap. However, we still need to raise at least £60,000 from the community to deliver these valuable improvements in 2012/13.
